The summit was attended by over 50 participants and focused on the report More Choices, More Chances in which Fleck provided the results of his studies on the alignment of high school career preparation programs and employer talent needs in Northeast Indiana.

Fleck currently serves as the executive director of Inspire Success, a 501(c)(3) charitable nonprofit based in Indiana with a mission to help those who help students succeed. During his 23 years in education, Fleck also served as Indiana's School Counseling Specialist and State Director of Career and Technical Education (CTE) at the Indiana Department of Education.
